<b>First Aid Methods:</b>	<b>Inhalation:</b>	If affected remove to fresh air, keep warm at rest. Obtain medical attention in severe cases.
	<b>Skin Contact:</b>	Immediately wash skin with copious amounts of water. In severe cases obtain medical advice.
	<b>Eye Contact:</b>	In case of contact, rinse immediately with plenty of water for at least 10-15 minutes. Obtain medical attention if irritation persists.
	<b>Ingestion:</b>	Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Wash out mouth with water and give copious amounts of water to drink. Do not induce vomiting. Obtain medical advice if patient is unwell.
<b>Fire:</b>	<b>Extinguishing media:</b>	Product not flammable Use suitable extinguishing media for surrounding fire. Use water spray to cool containers.
	<b>Special fire fighting procedures:</b>	Full protective equipment including self-contained respiratory protection
	<b>Unusual fire &amp; explosion hazards:</b>	In combustion it emits toxic fumes.
<b>Storage:</b>	Store in original containers, keep tightly closed when not in use, do not store below 5 deg C or above 30 deg C
